- MPH (FCM): Master of Public Health in Family and Community Medicine
- MScCH (FCM): Master of Science in Community Health in Family and Community Medicine
- MScCH (HPTE): Master of Science in Community Health in Health Practitioner Teacher Education

These programs are designed for licensed health professionals who are practicing in their country of primary residence and who are or expect to become teachers and leaders in their professional fields.

Special features of this program include:

- A flexible part time option
- No thesis or comprehensive exam requirement
- Field work practicum that allows for experiential learning and reinforces the theoretical principles learned in many of the courses
- Credit given for prior study in recognized programs

Around the world, the importance of Clinical Education based on sound educational principles and theories is being recognized. There is a growing need for teachers and education leaders with a firm grasp of scholarly work in this field.

Participants in the program hail from many different health disciplines and many parts of the world, contributing to a unique and stimulating venue for learning and collaboration.
