- "Only in exceptionally rare circumstances will a Banting Postdoctoral Fellowship be awarded to an applicant who is staying at the same institution or within the same research environment where they completed their PhD, PhD-equivalent or health professional degree." Please refer to the CIHR guidelines.
- Please note that the university does not have access to online application for Banting
 Postdoctoral Fellowship. Applicants will need to provide the supervisor/nominating unit with
 copies of each component of the application for the university review process.
- Applicants should be advised to have their references submitted with a <u>confidential copy</u> of their letter (which is also submitted online) directly to the nominating faculty/unit for use in their review.
