Salary is in accordance with the current CUPE 3902 Unit 3 Collective Agreement, below are the rates of pay for each pay category:

Sessional Lecturer I rate of pay will be \$ 8,323.20

Sessional Lecturer I - Long Term rate of pay will be \$8,531.28

Sessional Lecturer II rate of pay will be \$8,739.36

Sessional Lecturer III rate of pay will be \$8,947.44

All of the rates of pay above are effective September 1, 2019, and inclusive of vacation pay for a half course (F or S). Note that should rates stipulated in the Collective Agreement differ from rates stated in this posting, the rates stated in the Collective Agreement shall prevail.

Preference in hiring is given to qualified individuals advanced to the rank of Sessional Lecturer II or Sessional Lecturer III in accordance with Article 14:12.
