

New Graduate Students' Checklist:

1. Retain a copy of your Offer of Admission

Your U of T student number is printed on your Offer of Admission. You will need it to obtain your TCard.

2. Apply for a Study Permit (International Students)

If you are an international student and have not done so, please apply for a Study Permit. Refer to this link: <http://www.studentlife.utoronto.ca/cie/immigration>

3. Obtain your TCard (<http://tcard.utoronto.ca/>)

4. Activate your UTORid (<https://www.utorid.utoronto.ca/>)

5. Create your University Email (UTmail+)

Create your University-issued email account with your UTORid and new password at the UTORid webpage above. The University will deliver official correspondence to you via your University-issued email address.

6. Update personal information on ACORN (<http://www.acorn.utoronto.ca/>)

Record your new U of T email address into your Personal Information in ACORN. University correspondence will only be sent to your *@mail.utoronto.ca* email address.

7. Register as a student (Pay Fees)

To ensure that you are registered, pay at least the minimum academic and incidental fee, or request to 'Register without Payment' (Tuition Fee Deferral) in ACORN.
