SUMMARY OF DUTIES

Working with a Principal Investigator and members of a research team, the Research Assistant will have the opportunity to assist with a research project funded by the Canadian Institutes for Health Research focused on developing a comprehensive assessment on the strategies and collaborative efforts between public health and faith-based, community-based organizations to increase vaccine confidence in Ontario. The team is seeking a motivated research assistant with demonstrated interest in vaccine confidence and health service interventions to join the team starting from Summer or Fall of 2022 (start date negotiable).

We seek a self-motivated individual interested in learning and contributing to a review and evaluation of interventions to improve vaccine confidence. You will work remotely, or depending on the University of Toronto, mainly with a postdoctoral researcher and another research assistant on the following tasks:

- Support data analysis for the scoping review. You will work as a member of a grey literature review team to examine interventions that public health agencies use to improve vaccine confidence in minoritized populations. You will refine and complete the data extraction table with information from each article included in the literature review. Training in reference management software (Zotero) and systematic literature review software (COVIDENCE) will be provided.
- Participate in weekly meetings with the core research team to discuss task division and report on ongoing progress; monthly meetings with the larger research team are also required.
- Disseminate and collect questionnaires via REDCap to survey intervention strategies and support the core team with data cleaning and statistical analysis of the survey results. Training will be provided if needed.
