SUMMARY OF DUTIES

The Re:searching for 2SLGBTQ+ Health Team at the Dalla Lana School of Public Health is hiring a research assistant to support the Queering Reproductive Access study.

The Queering Reproductive Access (QRA) study is a PhD dissertation project that aims to understand the experiences of racialized/BIPOC 2SLGBTQ+ people accessing assisted reproductive technologies in Ontario. Through qualitative research we hope to identify policy and practice implications that can improve reproductive access and health equity for 2SLGBTQ+ communities.

We are hiring a part time (5 hours/week) research assistant. The initial appointment will be for 5.5 months, with the possibility of renewal.

Responsibilities will include contributing to: literature search, data collection (This is for tracking down discourse material), qualitative data verification, data analysis, and developing knowledge translation tools to share research findings. Other responsibilities may include tasks such as note-taking at meetings and assisting with research reports.

Qualifications: Previous experience in 2SLGBTQ+-focused research is a strong asset for this position. Knowledge of qualitative research and experience conducting literature searches are also considered strong assets for this position. You must be able to work well with members of diverse communities, including but not limited to Black, Indigenous and people of colour communities, and 2SLGBTQ+ communities. Knowledge of or experience working with any of these communities is a strong asset. Strong communication skills and experience working as part of a team and a familiarity with working remotely from home using a variety of digital tools (such as zoom, google docs, email, online scheduling) are also required for this position.
