Research for Post-pandemic Recovery

The New Frontiers in Research Fund Special Call: Research for Post-pandemic Recovery is now open.

The goal of this Special Call is to mobilize interdisciplinary, Canadian-led research efforts in support of a more equitable, sustainable, and resilient post-pandemic reality. It will support a diverse portfolio of projects that directly address one or more of the research priorities outlined in the UN Research Roadmap for the COVID-19 Recovery, including any of the UN's priorities and sub-priorities, including but not limited to the "quick-win", "best-buy" and "game-changer" priorities.

Value

Up to \$250,000 per year for two years, including indirect costs.

The <u>Critical Digital Humanities Initiative's Emerging Project Fund</u> offers funding for time-limited, faculty and librarian digital humanities project planning, international partnership networking, and/or tool-building through competitive seed grants. Each award of up to \$4,000 is designed to support faculty/librarian research in critical digital humanities and seeks to build research projects and teams that will be well positioned to apply for Tri-Council or other funding in the future.

Eligibility

All full-time faculty members and librarians at the University of Toronto, including research stream, teaching stream, and CLTAs.

Community Partnership Research Program

This initiative is intended to help create new collaborative research partnerships, or nurture early-stage partnerships, between the University and community partners, fostering access to each other's unique knowledge, expertise, and capabilities on issues of shared interest that, over time, may evolve into more established relationships that will attract external funding through, for example, the SSHRC Partnerships Grant program.

Value and Duration

Projects can request up to \$50,000 per year for one or two years, for up to a total of \$100,000. A total of \$300,000 is available through this competition.
