Call for Applications

SSHRC has updated the Insight Grant competition guidelines for the 2022 competition. Insight Grants support long-term research initiatives in the social sciences and humanities. They offer awards from \$7,000 to \$400,000 over 2 to 5 years, with a maximum annual budget of \$100,000. Funding is available to emerging and established scholars for projects conducted by an individual researcher or team of researchers.

This new collaboration on the <u>Globalink Research Award (GRA)</u> program now allows Canadian institutions to submit projects and host Ukrainian interns, who are full-time senior undergraduates, master's and PhD students, or postdoctoral fellows, from any discipline.

The award amount is \$6,000 with no financial contribution is required from the Canadian institution.

ECCC Climate Action and Awareness Fund (CAAF) Call for Proposals

The Climate Action and Awareness Fund (CAAF) through Environment and Climate Change Canada has opened a call for proposals (CFP) under its Support to Canadian Think Tanks and Academic Institutions priority. The objective of this call for proposals is to support projects that will identify, accelerate, and evaluate climate mitigation solutions and strategies that will contribute to achieving net-zero greenhouse gas emissions in Canada. Projects seeking a total of \$250K up to \$1 million are eligible and can be up to a maximum of 2 years in length.

Net-zero research projects could include activities related to literature reviews and knowledge synthesis, qualitative or quantitative analysis, model development, engagement with experts and stakeholders, or community-based research, aimed at building knowledge on net-zero at the national, provincial, territorial, regional, or local scales, including findings specific to Indigenous communities.
