List of Duties:

- Collects information from residents in-person, following a predetermined templated list of questions.
- Collects information using laptop, tablets, (and paper forms where needed).
- Perform Digital Data Entry (remote or in-person)
- Carry out in-person observations in communal settings in Long-Term Care homes, following a predetermined checklist.
- Attend Training, Staff Meetings, and Check-Ins (online & in-person)

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree in Social Work, Public Health, Nursing, or Medicine with considerable relevant experience.
- Master’s degree preferred.
- Experience working with older adults and staff in Ontario Long-Term Care homes
- Experience using tablets/laptops for data entry
