
Navigating the School of Graduate Studies Online Application

The information and screen shots below will help you in the submission of your application to a graduate degree program in the Department of Public Health Sciences.


Review the degree programs and fields of study carefully as you may not be eligible for all degree programs or all fields of study within a degree program (http://www.dlsph.utoronto.ca/programs/). Read the instructions below and follow the steps for program selection in the SGS Online Application.

1) Start New Application: Choose the Start session. Applications for all Degree Programs start in **Fall 2024** EXCEPT MPH Indigenous Health, which starts in **Summer 2024**.

For all programs except MPH Indigenous Health, choose Fall 2024 – Summer 2025:




For MPH Indigenous Health, choose Fall 2023 – Summer 2024:



2) Program Selection:

a) Graduate Unit: Locate Department of Public Health Sciences in the drop down menu:



b) Choose the Attendance Type: Full-time or Part-time

c) **Program of Study:** Review the Degree Programs offered in the <u>Graduate Department of Public Health Sciences</u> before you make your selection.




- d) Select up to 3 **Collaborative Specializations** in which you might be interested in participating. Each Collaborative Specialization has its own application process and associated deadlines. - 3) Next, you will need to enter your personal and contact information, your complete post-secondary academic history, and indicate whether or not English Language Proficiency (ELP) test scores are required.

You must indicate, in your application profile, <u>all</u> post-secondary institutions you have attended, even if you feel it is not relevant to the DLSPH program to which you are applying, and even if you did not complete the program.


If ELP is required, please enter your scores into your application profile and remember to request your testing agency to forward an electronic copy of your scores to the **University of Toronto, Enrolment Services.** Please note that a university education in English may not be considered sufficient (e.g. TOEFL/TWE is <u>required</u> for graduates from such countries as India, Pakistan, Bangladesh and Saudi Arabia). A Medical Residency in Canada <u>does not</u> satisfy the ELP requirement, nor does living/working in an English speaking country. If in doubt, take a test of English Language Proficiency.

4) For applicants to **MPH program in <u>Nutrition and Dietetics</u>** and <u>Occupational & Environmental Health</u>, please complete the questions regarding your preference of Emphasis.


MPH – Nutrition and Dietetics

5) Once you have completed the review of your application, you will visit the Review page where you will be notified of any items that are still pending.



Check this page regularly until all documents, including Recommendations from both referees have been received.

6) Finally, you will need to submit your application fee payment. Once all of the required information has been entered, all documents submitted, and the application fee payment has been received, your application will be ready for review by the Admissions Committee.
