

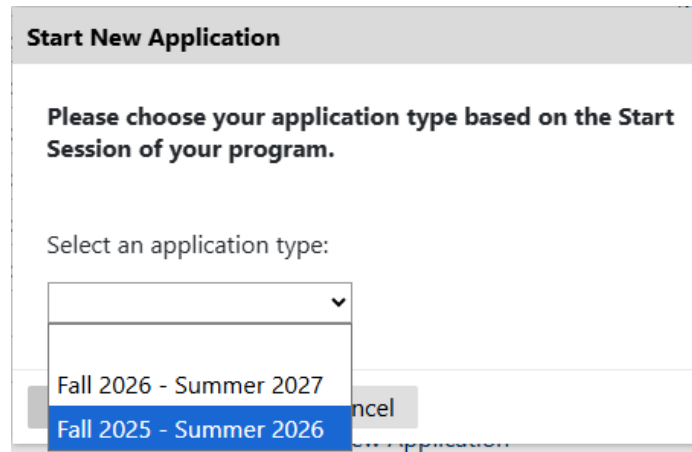
Navigating the School of Graduate Studies Online Application

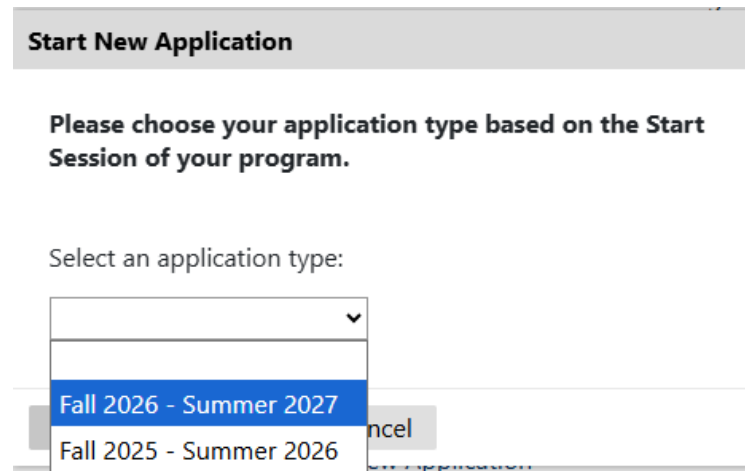

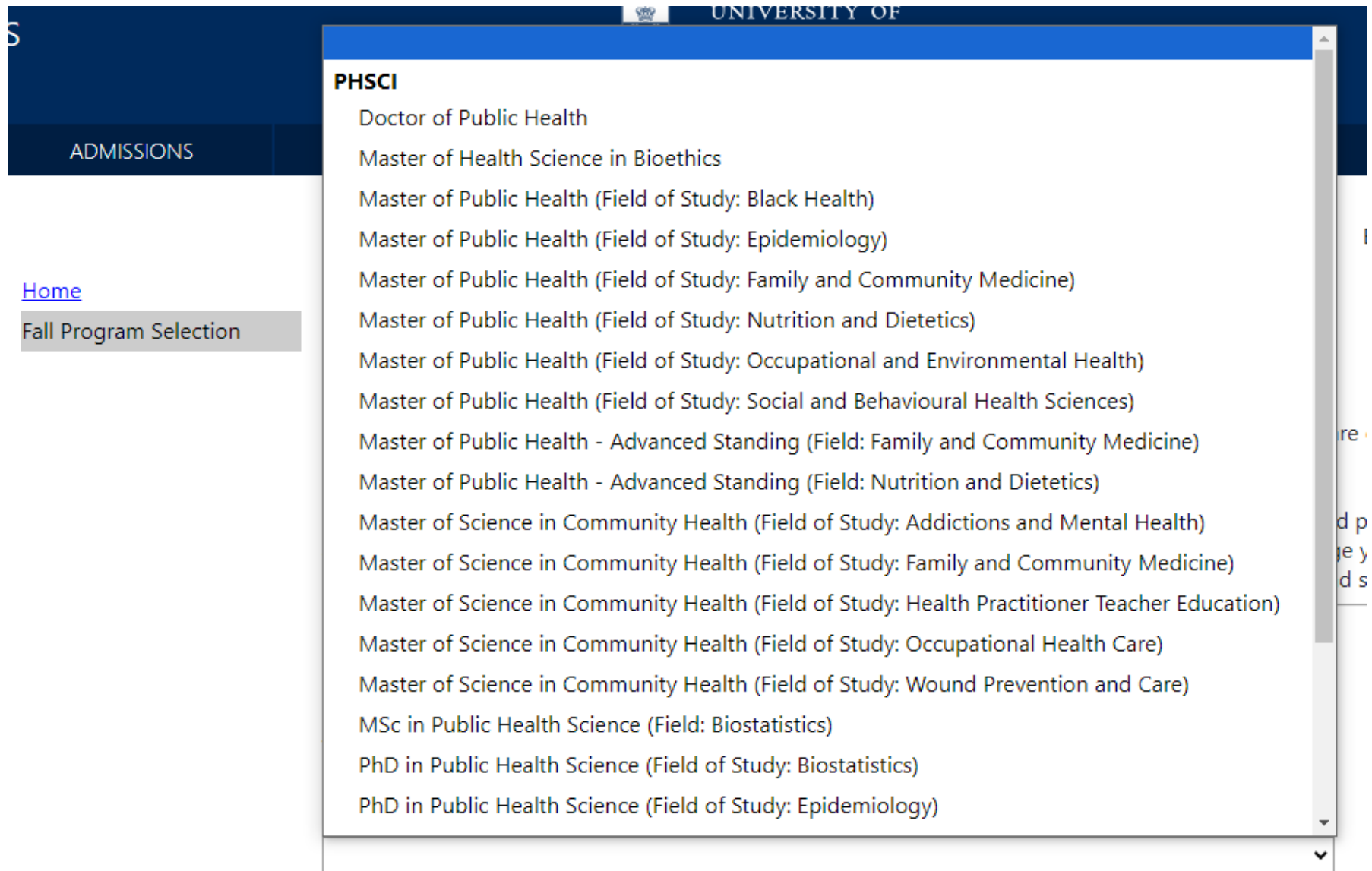

- 3) Next, you will need to enter your personal and contact information, your *complete* post-secondary academic history, and indicate whether English Language Proficiency (ELP) test scores are required. ELP is required and must be established by all applicants *who completed their university degree(s) outside of Canada, where the language of instruction is not uniformly English*. Please refer to the information on our [website](#) regarding the ELP requirement.

You must indicate, in your application profile, all post-secondary institutions you have attended, even if you feel it is not relevant to the DLSPH program to which you are applying, and even if you did not complete the program at that institution.

The Admission Committee must be able to review your complete academic record, which means all of the post-secondary *courses* you have completed and the *grades* you received. Uploading a copy of your diploma is not sufficient.

If ELP is required, please enter your scores into your application profile and remember to request your testing agency to forward an electronic copy of your scores to the **University of Toronto, Enrolment Services**. **Please note** that a university education in English may not be considered sufficient (e.g. TOEFL/TWE is required for graduates from such countries as India, Pakistan, Bangladesh and Saudi Arabia). A Medical Residency in Canada does not satisfy the ELP requirement, nor does living/working in an English-speaking country. If in doubt, take a test of English Language Proficiency.
